- Work takes place summer 2017. Results early 2018.


Geoscience BC -Search Phase III

Search Phase III is an airborne survey which will build understanding of geology in north central and northeastern BC and highlight potential for mineral deposits.

Feedback from previous surveys shows that these projects encourage exploration and, over the long-term, provide the information needed to bring responsible development and investment to BC.

As with all Geoscience BC projects, data will be made openly available to communities, First Nations, the resource sector and government as an unbiased and independent planning tool.
