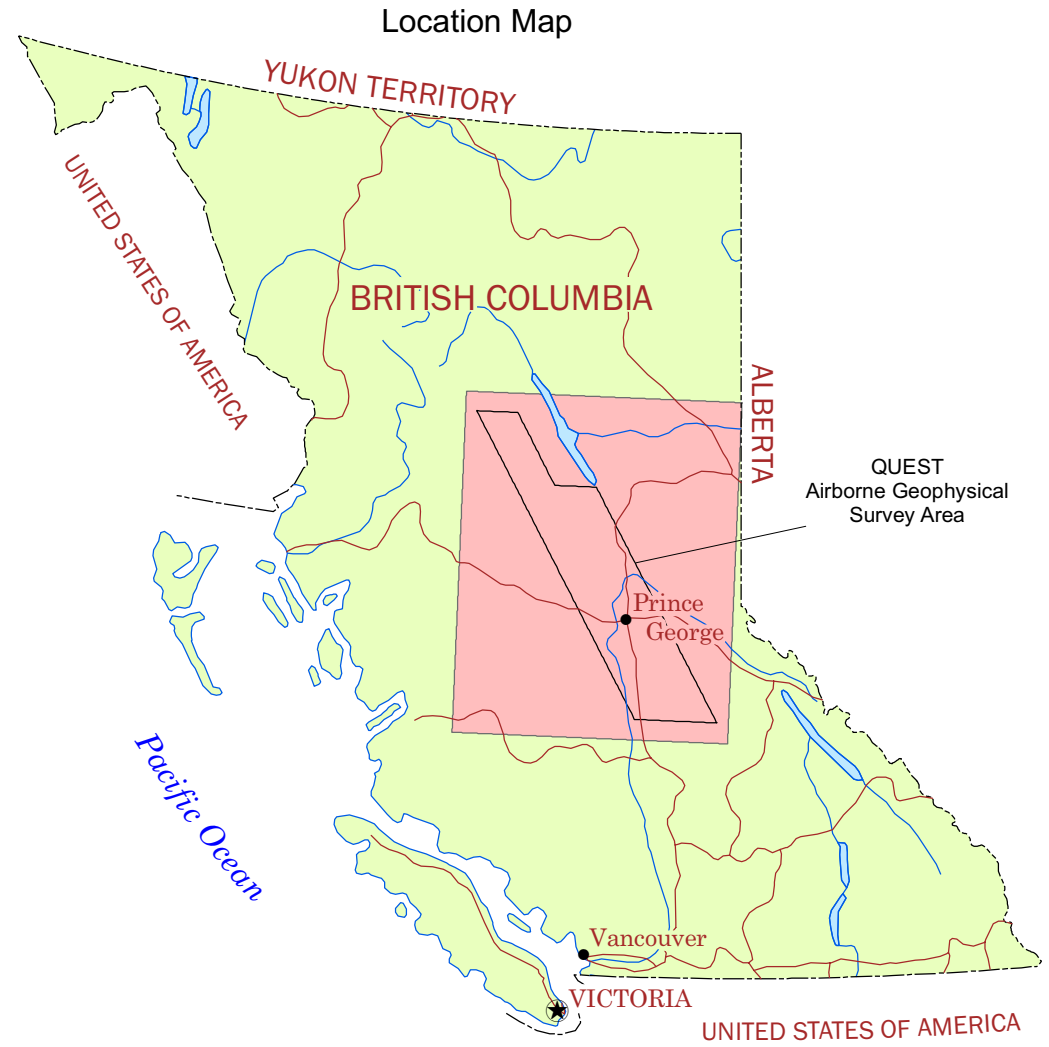

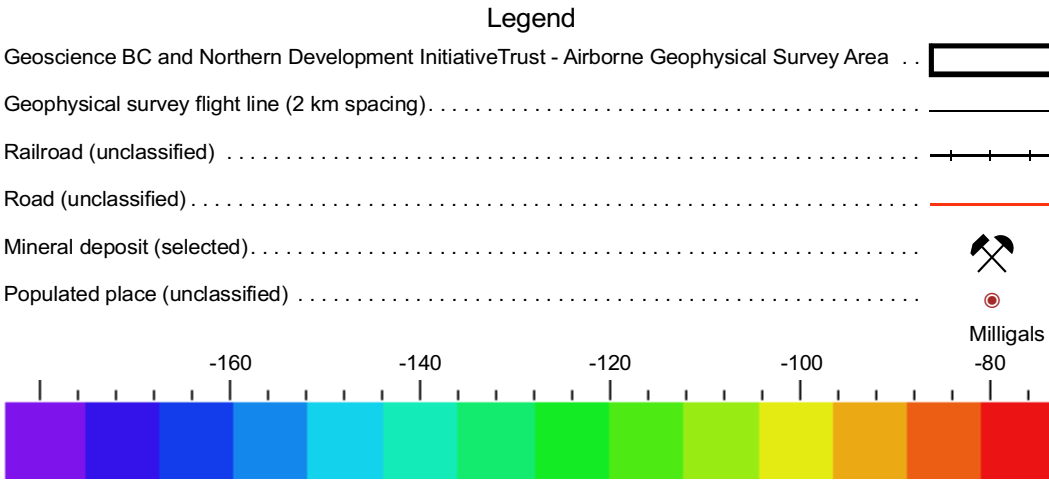

Between December 2007 and March 28, 2008, Sander Geophysics Limited (SGL) carried out a high-definition airborne gravity survey on behalf of Geoscience BC and the Northern Trust as part of the QUEST project in central British Columbia.

The survey covered a large block of ground over 46,500 square kilometres in an area extending from just north of Williams Lake to approximately 100 kilometres north of Mackenzie, B.C. There were 23,400 line kilometres flown with a line spacing of 1 kilometre.

The primary geophysical sensor included SGL's airborne gravity system designated AIRGro (Airborne Inertially Referenced Gravimeter).

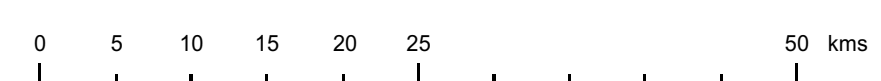
